1.0 Company Overview

Huaqin Technology Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as “Huaqin Technology”) was founded in 2005 and is headquartered in Shanghai, China. It is a global intelligent hardware platform enterprise. Huaqin Technology operates five major R&D centers in Shanghai, Wuxi, Xi'an, Nanchang, and Dongguan; two domestic manufacturing bases in Nanchang and Dongguan; and three overseas manufacturing bases in Vietnam, Mexico (planned), and India. Our products and services are distributed across more than 100 countries and regions worldwide, serving over 100 global operators, and providing hundreds of millions of intelligent terminal products each year to hundreds of millions of consumers worldwide, including smartphones, tablets, computers, smart wearables, AIoT products, data center products, and automotive electronics.

To fulfill corporate social responsibility and better achieve sustainable development, Huaqin Technology is committed to responsible sourcing and business practices across social, environmental, and ethical dimensions with respect to products, employees, and suppliers. The annual conflict minerals report of Huaqin Technology Co., Ltd. complies with the requirements of the Responsible Minerals Initiative. This report outlines the process by which Huaqin Technology sources mineral raw materials for its products, ensuring that minerals are sourced in a humane manner and do not involve child labor, human trafficking, or slavery.

Huaqin Technology commits to not supporting or using conflict minerals or minerals of unknown origin, including tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold, cobalt, and mica, and supports the actions of the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) and the Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI) on conflict minerals. With reference to the guidelines of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and the RBA on conflict minerals, we have carried out responsible supply chain sourcing through Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry (RCOI) and Due Diligence (DD). These initiatives represent internationally recognized industry standard practices and form the design framework of our conflict minerals program.

2.0 Definitions / Terminology

Definitions

Conflict Minerals (CM) refer to metallic minerals such as gold (Au), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), and tin (Sn) (collectively referred to as 3TG) that are produced from mines located in conflict areas controlled by non-governmental military groups or non-military factions in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. The trade of these minerals may finance conflict activities in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or its adjoining countries, thereby giving rise to risks such as human rights abuses and environmental degradation.

3.0 Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry (RCOI)

As tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold are commonly used in electronic manufacturing, Huaqin Technology considers all its hardware products to be within the scope of this report. Therefore, it is not necessary to maintain a specific product list.

Huaqin Technology has conducted a Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry (RCOI) to determine whether conflict minerals originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or Covered Countries (CC). We apply the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT), which is widely used across the industry, and utilize the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) program of the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) for the purposes of RCOI. We also require our suppliers to use the CMRT with their upstream suppliers.

As part of our RCOI, we surveyed 100% of our suppliers and achieved a 100% response rate. Upon receipt of the responses, we carefully review the completeness and consistency of the information provided and directly verify suppliers' conflict minerals policies during this process. Any CMRTs that are incomplete or contain inconsistencies are returned to suppliers for correction and are deemed invalid until resubmitted..

4.0 Commitment to Conflict-Free Minerals

Based on the efforts undertaken through the RCOI, Huaqin Technology has reasonable grounds to believe that the conflict minerals used do not originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or Covered Countries. Accordingly, we conducted due diligence on the sources of the minerals.

Huaqin Technology has completed surveys covering 100% of its suppliers to verify that the metals used in the supply chain do not originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or Covered Countries. Huaqin Technology applies the CMRT survey to all its suppliers, not solely to those identified as supplying "in-scope products". We believe that reporting all smelters and refiners (SORs) in our supply chain, regardless of whether they supply materials used in our products, enables further due diligence as needed and reflects our commitment to social responsibility.

5.0 Implementation of the OECD Due Diligence Guidance

Huaqin Technology adopts the guidelines of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and uses the *OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas* (hereinafter referred to as the "Guidance") to guide the management of mineral sourcing.

In accordance with the Guidance, we must clearly identify our position within the overall minerals supply chain. As a company that sells technology, products, and

services to brand customers, Huaqin Technology is positioned as a “downstream company” in the minerals supply chain, between smelters/refiners and retailers. For most of the materials we purchase, Huaqin Technology has no direct influence over their composition or quality. As many of these materials are industry-standard products, we typically negotiate with suppliers only on commercial and legal terms (such as pricing), rather than on the specific composition or sourcing of the materials used in their products. For example, apart from restricting hazardous substances, we do not instruct suppliers of CPUs, memory, tablets, batteries, or other electronic components regarding the parts, materials, or components used in their products.

Huaqin Technology does not directly purchase ore or refined minerals in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), Covered Countries (CC), or any other countries. Nor does it have any direct channels to obtain information on upstream ore, buyers/sellers/integrators/intermediaries, transportation routes, or smelters or refiners (SOR). Huaqin Technology’s supply chain is not only many tiers removed from the mine of origin, but also many tiers removed from the SOR.

To date, Huaqin Technology is neither a manufacturer nor a party that “contracts to manufacture” as defined under the Dodd-Frank Act. The majority of our procurement expenditures are allocated to final assembly and testing operations, while our suppliers more often act in the role of distributors or retailers. Across the entire supply chain, Huaqin Technology serves as an “outsourced manufacturing channel” for downstream brand customers, while acting as a “sales channel” for upstream suppliers. In summary, many of our key components are industry-standard components that are indistinguishable from those supplied to our suppliers’ other customers. Nevertheless, Huaqin Technology has conducted conflict minerals due diligence covering 100% of our procurement expenditures.

As a result, there are specific and complex challenges related to data accuracy, coverage, reporting year, confidentiality, data scope, language/communication/translation, and the lack of any direct business relationships that would enable direct transparency into the supply chain. Consequently, once ores are smelted and refined, it is extremely challenging for a downstream company like Huaqin Technology to determine the precise origin of the minerals.

The *Guidance* explicitly acknowledges this complexity and further states that:

Downstream companies should make their best efforts to identify and assess the due diligence practices of smelters and refiners in their supply chains and to evaluate whether such entities comply with the due diligence measures set out in the *Guidance*. Downstream companies may participate in the establishment of industry mechanisms that assess smelters’ and refiners’ compliance with the *Guidance*, and may use the information provided by such mechanisms to help implement the recommendations of the *Guidance*.

This distinction between upstream and downstream companies reflects the fact that internal control systems based on tracing minerals owned by enterprises are generally no longer feasible after minerals have been smelted, because refined metals entering consumer markets constitute only a small portion of the various components of end products. In light of these practical difficulties, downstream companies should establish internal controls with respect to their direct suppliers, and may coordinate collective industry initiatives to influence sub-tier suppliers, overcome practical challenges, and effectively implement the due diligence recommendations set out in the *Guidance*.

6.0 Actions Taken by Huaqin Technology

The following measures have been taken by Huaqin Technology to comply with the requirements of the OECD, the Dodd-Frank Act, and the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA), and to prevent the use of conflict minerals.

6.1 Establishment of a Strong Management System

- We have established a formal and publicly accountable sourcing policy.
- Huaqin Technology has established a formal organizational structure for sustainability and conflict minerals management. An ESG governance framework is in place, under which corporate social responsibility is included, and a dedicated social responsibility team is responsible for implementing conflict minerals programs, actions, and reporting.
- We have established a transparent supply chain control system within Huaqin Technology to identify smelters and refiners (SORs) associated with conflict minerals. First, we have internally disclosed the *Conflict Minerals Use Management Procedure*, which defines conflict minerals, responsibilities, and workflows. Second, we use the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) to survey our supply chain, which serves as the primary mechanism for identifying smelters and refiners supplying 3TG to components in our supply chain and for assessing risks related to 3TG. All records are retained in the SRM system database. Finally, after collecting smelter and refiner data from suppliers, Huaqin Technology utilizes the RMI Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP) to preliminarily determine whether smelters participate in the RMAP.
- We have taken a number of measures to establish and continuously strengthen supplier engagement.
- ✓ We have established long-term partnerships with most suppliers to build influence and enhance compliance. The majority of our procurement expenditures are sourced from an approved vendor list (AVL), resulting in a high level of control.

- ✓ We have established standards and policies and, through formal communication, entered into social responsibility agreements with suppliers. We also maintain a formal Supplier Code of Conduct that further incorporates our requirements.
- ✓ We assess our suppliers' compliance with the RBA Code of Conduct, which includes conflict minerals due diligence requirements. We have raised expectations for suppliers and require them to cease using non-conformant smelters.
- ✓ Huaqin Technology actively participates in RMI programs. RMI tools and guidance documents help Huaqin Technology address risks related to responsible minerals sourcing. We also seek to invest human resources by participating in RMI China Smelter Engagement Teams (SETs) and serving as Single Points of Contact (SPOCs) for Asian 3TG and cobalt SORs, to promote the participation of Chinese smelters.
- ✓ Responsible sourcing has been embedded into Huaqin Technology's supply chain management business processes. Our supplier social responsibility audit checklist includes indicators for suppliers' compliance with our conflict minerals expectations. This checklist provides critical information for business decision-making.
- ✓ If a supplier is identified as engaging in human trafficking, slavery, or child labor, or as using conflict minerals and fails to take corrective actions, we will cease purchasing its goods or services.
- Huaqin Technology has multiple grievance mechanisms for company- or industry-related concerns. Internally, we have company policies (the Employee Handbook). Externally, we have the Human Rights Policy of Huaqin Technology Co., Ltd. (available on the Company's official website).

6.2 Identification and Assessment of Risks

Given the many complex risks associated with ensuring a conflict-free supply chain, and recognizing that the *Guidance* acknowledges the difficulty for downstream companies to identify upstream actors, Huaqin Technology aims to use standard, industry-wide programs to identify SORs in the supply chain in order to determine whether conflict minerals originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or neighboring countries.

The principal risks arising from this include:

- Whether SORs are located in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or surrounding countries;
- Whether SORs source ores from the DRC or Covered Countries;
- Whether the information provided by SORs and at each tier of the supply chain is sufficiently accurate;
- Whether basic engagement with smelters/refiners (such as emails, telephone calls, internet surveys, on-site investigations, or visits) provides sufficient confidence that conflict is not being financed;

- Given the global nature of the supply chain, whether materials processed by most SORs pose risks in their respective locations;
- Even if SORs are reported in our supply chain, whether we can be certain that the minerals are present in our products.

6.3 Design and Implementation of Risk Mitigation Strategies

Accordingly, Huaqin Technology's strategic objective for effectively addressing and controlling risks is to understand all SORs in our supply chain, regardless of whether their materials are present in our products, and to either ensure their compliance or ultimately cease using them. To advance this objective, Huaqin Technology's risk response strategies include:

- **Smelter/Refiner Certification**

- ✓ We continue to utilize the RMAP to ensure that only conformant smelters are used, and leverage Smelter Engagement Teams (SETs) to address non-conformant and invalid SORs.

- **Smelter/Refiner Disengagement**

- ✓ As hundreds of companies and many RBA/RMI members share many of the same SORs, our strategy is to leverage collective industry influence to drive positive change. If such efforts are unsuccessful, Huaqin Technology will work with industry partners to cease using smelters that refuse to undergo audits and certification.

- ✓ It should be noted that there are significant challenges in actually removing verified SORs from the supply chain. Merely requiring the removal of non-conformant SORs (sometimes viewed as a 'negative' approach) may not itself guarantee their effective exclusion from the supply chain, thereby undermining confidence in the outcome. Huaqin Technology recognizes that positive efforts are beneficial to all stakeholders over the long term.

- **Internal Reporting and Awareness**

- ✓ **Project Status:** Report the initiation and completion status of the annual CMRT survey.

- ✓ **Communications:** Monthly updates on key news, events, focus areas, and key links.

- ✓ **Education:** Conduct an annual training program for all employees.

- ✓ **Quarterly Metrics:** Quarterly reporting on project status and recent developments.

- **External Reporting**

- ✓ Public responsible minerals sourcing policies and reports.

- ✓ Public disclosure through our sustainability reports, annual reports, and official website.

✓ Provide our due diligence measures to customers and external stakeholders upon request.

✓ Maintain our public policy on conflict minerals.

- OECD Due Diligence *Guidance*

✓ Huaqin Technology will continue to actively promote compliance with the *Guidance*, take measures to integrate the five-step framework into our management systems, and ensure the widest possible dissemination of the *Guidance* requirements.

Huaqin Technology does not limit or selectively conduct due diligence only on SORs whose minerals are present in our products in order to improve reporting statistics. We take action on all SORs reported in our supply chain, regardless of whether their materials are present in our products. We believe that reporting all SORs in our supply chain and conducting due diligence on them in a consistent manner demonstrates a higher level of social responsibility.

6.4 Public Disclosure of Due Diligence Reports

As described above, Huaqin Technology publicly discloses our due diligence policies and the results of their implementation. We also provide information on social and environmental responsibility on our website and in our annual sustainability reports.

This report and all other sustainability initiatives of Huaqin Technology are available on the Company's official website.

7.0 Additional Actions to Be Taken

Huaqin Technology will take further actions in the future to enhance our contributions to promoting conflict-free minerals and to sustain the achievements already made.

We will:

- Continue to work closely with suppliers to obtain necessary information on the sources of 3TG used in materials or components of products.
- Increase staffing resources for further program development.
- Adopt professional methods, such as third-party data verification or cross-referencing, to validate the accuracy of conflict minerals information provided by suppliers.

8.0 Key Smelter/Refiner Metrics

Through Huaqin Technology's RCOI and due diligence processes, we have identified the Smelters and Refiners (SORs) in our supply chain and work to confirm their compliance with conflict-free standards.

- Supplier CMRT response rate: 100%
- Smelter/Refiner conformance rate: 100%

- 100% of our suppliers use the CMRT with their own suppliers and require them to comply with our responsible sourcing requirements
- Non-conformant SORs: 0
- Reporting: Status reports provided to the procurement team on a quarterly basis
- Education: Annual training provided to all relevant personnel

9.0 Countries of Origin and Smelter/Refiner Lists

9.1 Countries of Origin

The Dodd-Frank Act requires issuers to identify and disclose the mine or location of origin of conflict minerals. At the same time, the Dodd-Frank Act recognizes the OECD requirements, which allow downstream companies certain limitations in determining the mine or location of origin. Accordingly, our efforts to determine mineral origins include:

- Identifying SORs and their locations in our supply chain through the CMRT
- Determining mine names and locations as provided in the CMRT
- Verifying legitimate SORs provided by the RMI, including those recognized by highly credible industry organizations (such as LBMA, RJC, and TI-CMC)
- Auditing and certifying SORs through the RMAP, which provides limited mineral origin and classification methodologies:

✓ L1 — Countries not identified as conflict-affected areas or as potential sources of smuggling or illicit export

✓ L2 — Countries suspected of smuggling or exporting 3TG

✓ L3 — The Democratic Republic of the Congo or neighboring countries (Covered Countries)

✓ Democratic Republic of the Congo

10.0 Due Diligence on Cobalt & Mica

The extraction of cobalt and mica is associated with the risks identified in Annex II of the OECD *Guidance*. Huaqin Technology has implemented OECD sourcing due diligence and expects suppliers to participate in our due diligence procedures for cobalt and mica.

Similar to 3TG, responsible sourcing of cobalt and mica is a complex issue that requires industry-wide collaboration. Huaqin Technology fully supports the RMI's efforts to address materials beyond 3TG. Since 2021, we have formally adopted the EMRT (Cobalt & Mica Reporting Template) obtained via the

RBA website to conduct comprehensive supply chain due diligence for cobalt and mica. This effort covered 100% of suppliers and achieved a 100% response rate.
